## **Thesis Abstract**

### **Al-Aqabas Two Pledges of Allegiance - A Missionary Study**

*Praise be to Allah, prayers and peace on the best of the Prophets and Messengers, our Prophet Muhammad and his family and companions.*

I addressed the subject of "Al-Aqaba's Two Pledges of Allegiance - A Missionary Study" where I illustrated in the introductory chapter the events and facts that took place between the Prophet and the tribes at the time of the invitation to Islam, and how their response to the Prophet was; and that God the Almighty guided the *Ansar* to accept that blessed invitation and therefore they pledged to the Prophet, Peace be upon him, allegiance, obedience, protection and support to him as well as Islamic Jihad for the cause of Islam. I also mentioned the most important effects of Al-Aqaba's Two Pledges of Allegiance, which are: the spread of Islam in the city of the Prophet (Al-Madina) and the rise of the Islamic State, the demise of war, and others matters.

Chapter Three: the missionary lessons associated with the subject of the call (Da'wa) where I have dealt with religion, Islamic law (Sharia), and ethics.

Chapter Four: the missionary lessons associated with the means and methods, where I have addressed the most important means and methods learned from the Al-Aqaba's Two Pledges of Allegiance.

Then the conclusion of the research, which included the most important findings and recommendations as reached.
