Thesis Abstract

The study comprises a preface, an introductory chapter, and four chapters. The introductory chapter is devoted to a brief biography of Shaikh Mohammad ibn Al-Ithaimeen may God have mercy on him. In the first chapter, the researcher speaks about the origins of the method of Shaikh Al-Ithaimeen in Da'wa (call to Islam) and Ihtisab and characteristics of that methods in two sections where the first addresses the fundamentals Al-Ithaimeen's approach; and the second sections addresses the characteristics of the approach. The second chapter is devoted to means and methods used by Shaikh Al-Ithaimeen in his call and divides into two sections, one is for the means and the other is for the methods. The third chapter deals with the arenas in which Shaikh Al-Ithaimeen exercised his Da'wa where it is divided in five sections each for one of the following fields, respectively: (the mosque, house, schools & universities, Haj & Umrah, Islamic centers abroad, summer centers and educational camps). As the Da'wa of Shaikh Al-Ithaimeen gained continuing success and acceptance, thanks to God, the fourth chapter is dedicated to the discussion of the success factors where the personal factors are dealt with in the first section and the external factors are dealt with in the second section. The study concluded in mentioning the most important findings and recommendations. Finally the study is provided with indexes of the Quranic verses, prophetic traditions (Hadiths), poems, a list of key references and sources, and finally an index of topics.
