"Factors related with aggression as seen by youths"

First Chapter:

Aggression is considered a universal phenomenon in all human societies. Aggression means assumption of hostility when dealing with others. People are not aggressive by nature but nature of life and style of social upbringing are the factors that lead human to acquire aggression.

Importance of study:
